

Minutes of continuation of Public Hearing regarding Zoning Requests. Continued from July 1, 1975 at 7:30 P.M. The continuation date and date of these minutes July 7, 1975, at 8:30 A.M. held in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building.

Vice-Mayor McElroy called the meeting to order and advised that this was a continuation of the Public Hearing regarding a zoning change from General Business to Heavy Industrial located in the Ramsey Section of Norton, commencing at 15th Street S.E. and continuing in an easterly direction to Guest River, and bounded on the south by the railroad right-of-way *into* 7160 the north by Kentucky Avenue, as requested by property owner George Hunnicutt.

George Hunnicutt advised Council and those present that he would remain in the audience and be recognized as the applicant in question.

Harold Ray McArthur, a resident of 14th Street S.E. and Miss Octavia Stidham, a resident of 13th Street S.E., voiced objections to the rezoning request.

The Vice-Mayor after having exhausted all questions and comments relative to the rezoning request, called for the question.

On motion by Jim Humphreys, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council resolved to accept the recommendation of the City Planning Commission and to rezone the above described property from General Business to Heavy Industrial. Voting as follows:
