

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on March 19, 1974 at 7:00 P.M. with Mayor Fulks presiding.

Present: Ike Fulks, Robert Leonard, W.F. McElroy

Also Present: Milas D. Franks, City Manager & Montie Meeks, Attorney

Absent: Jim Humphreys and Roy Roberts

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved with the following correction made: On motion by Robert Leonard, seconded by Jim Humphreys and carried by unanimous vote council moved that Cecil Gardner, Bill Necessary, *Zepher Ke* be recommended for appointment to serve on the Real Estate Appraisal Board.

Roger Jenkins appeared before council and advised that the City Manager had informed him that the City has a moratorium on extension of Water & Sewer Services into the county, therefore, could not provide these services to property he desired to purchase in the Dorechester Area of Wise County. Mr. Jenkins inquired of the City Council as to what had been done about lifting the moratorium on 6504 utility services in the County.

Council advised that until further notice the Moratorium would remain in effect.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Robert Leonard and carried by unanimous roll call vote, council moved to adopt the resolution of Participation in the Chapter 10 Mental Health Center Construction Grant. (Page 98) 6505

On motion by Robert Leonard, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved to adopt the resolution of agreed participation for Chapter 10 Mental Health Center Site Acquisition and Development. (Page 98) 6506

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Robert Leonard and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved to adopt Resolution for Annual Staffing and Operation of Chapter 10 Board. (Page 98) 6507

Council agreed to meet with the City School Board March 26, 1974 at 4:30 P.M. to discuss teacher's salaries. 6508

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Robert Leonard, council unanimously reappointed Robert Barton to a five year term to serve on the Housing Appeals Board, said term effective February 28, 1974. 6509

City Manager brought Council up to date on Grievance Procedure. He advised that in accordance with State Law it would be necessary for the council to adopt a Grievance Procedure prior to June 30, 1974. 6510

Mayor Fulks advised council that Charlie Daniels was ready to start removal of the Lay Building. 6511

Mayor Fulks advised council that he had discussed with Charlie Daniels 6512 a street grade problem at the entrance to Mr. Daniel's property on Spruce Street.

There being no further business to come before council same adjourned.
