

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on May 1, 1973 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Fulks presiding.

Present: Ike Fulks, Robert Leonard, Jim Humphreys

Absent: W.F. McElroy

Also Present: Milas Franks, City Manager & Montie Meeks, Attorney

Mr. Jim Humphreys nominated Roy Roberts for councilman to fill the unexpired term of Archie Woods, resigned. 6290

Mr. Leonard moved that nominations be closed and Mr. Roberts be elected by acclamation. Upon roll call vote Mr. Roberts was elected to fill the unexpired term of Archie V. Woods, resigned, said term to expire June 30, 1974. 6291

Councilman Leonard nominated Jim Humphreys as Vice Mayor of the City of Norton. 6292

Councilman Leonard moved nominations be closed and that Mr. Jim Humphreys be elected as Vice Mayor by acclamation. Upon roll call vote Mr. Jim Humphreys was elected as Vice Mayor of the City of Norton. 6293

The Clerk administered Oath of Office to Roy Roberts. 6294

Mr. Franks brought council uptodate on status of Flag Rock Recreation Area, advising that City was fast approaching the point where the City can ask for bids for the construction of Flag Rock Project. 6295

Mr. Jim Vickers of Lenowisco Planning District appeared before council and discussed with them the availability of funding monies for Sewer Improvement in the City of Norton. Council discussed this matter at length with Mr. Vickers. 6296

On motion by Jim Humphreys, seconded by Robert Leonard and carried by unanimous vote, council moved that City Manager be directed to write letter to Environmental Protection Agency so that the City may get on the eligibility list to make application at proper time for Grant Assistance. 6297

The City Manager was instructed to arrange a meeting with Town Council of Wise, County Supervisors, and City Council to discuss the original agreement of consolidating the sewer and water systems of the City and Town of Wise. 6298

Mr. Vickers presented regional water quality management plan and asked that the Council consider passing resolution of adoption of this plan. 6299

On motion by Jim Humphreys, seconded by Robert Leonard and carried by unanimous vote council moved that the resolution regarding regional water quality improvement plan be adopted. 6300

Mr. Franks discussed with council sewer extension to Greene's Mobile Home Park. He advised that before this line could be extended the City would have to enter into a contract with L. & N. Railroad 6301

with and initial charge of \$25.00 plus \$24.00 per year. The City Manager recommended that a contract be entered into with Bill Greene, T/A as Greene's Mobile Homes and City of Norton making Bill Greene, 6302 T/A Greene's Mobile Home reimburse the City of Norton for initial fee and also yearly fee to Railroad Company.

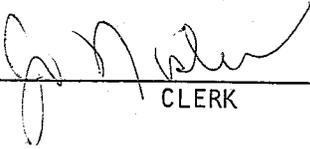
On motion by Robert Leonard, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote council moved that City of Norton enter into contract with Bill Greene. T/A Greene's Mobile Home Park pertaining to sewer 6303 easement across L. & N. Property as described in the contract.

Mr. Franks advised council he had three pending matters he would like to discuss with council before the end of the fiscal year. 6304

1. Water & Sewer Rates
2. Proposed trailer tax assessment.
3. Proposed personnel rules and regulations.

Council authorized City Manager to have ordinances prepared on new Water and Sewer rates for next council meeting. 6305

There being no further business to come before the council same adjourned.
