

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on July 3, 1973 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Ike Fultz presiding.

Present: Robert Leonard, W.F. McElroy, Roy Roberts, Jim Humphreys, Ike Fultz

Also Present: Milas D. Franks, City Manager & Montie Meeks, City Attorney

Mayor Fultz appointed Mr. Franks as temporary clerk.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mrs. Mills appeared before City Council and advised that she was experiencing property damage from the residence of trailer park near her residence at 15th Street Southwest, she also advised that 3 trailers were located on the right-of-way of 15th Street. 6351

Council instructed City Manager to identify street right-of-way and if trailers are on public property to have same removed. 6352

Mr. Franks presented a letter to council from Jim Ossea requesting that a portion of 15th Street Southwest be closed. Council denied Mr. Ossea's request. 6353

Ralph Rasnick appeared before City Council and requested that council endorse The Emergency Medical Service Committee of Virginia Appalachian Health Service as the responsible agency for requesting grant assistance from the Johnson Wood Foundation for funding of an emergency communication system. 6354

Matter tabled until next meeting to allow the City Attorney time to study the set up of the corporation and its proposed By-laws. 6355

City Manager presented to council a revised personnel policy for City employees. After considerable discussion and revision on motion by Jim Humphreys seconded by Roy Roberts and roll call vote the City council unanimously adopted the revised personnel policy to be effective July 1, 1973. 6356

On motion by W.F. McElroy seconded by Robert Leonard council unanimously appointed G. Edward McElyea to fill the unexpired term of Harold Hagy, to serve on the Norton Redevelopment and Housing Authority Board - Said term to expire January 28th, 1976. 6357

Mr. George Wharton, Chairman of Cumberland Airport Commission appeared before council and requested their approval of Amendment #1 to grant agreement for Project #7 -51-0060-01 (Contract No. FA-EA-1040) 6358

On motion by Jim Humphreys seconded by Robert Leonard and carried by unanimous roll call vote council approved the amended Grant Agreement pending proper evaluation of the City Attorney. 6359

There being no further business to come before council same adjourned.
