

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on November 7, 1973 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Fulks presiding.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Franks brought council up-to-date on Bridge Replacement Program on Route 58. He advised that the tentative advertising date has been set for late 1974.

Mr. Franks advised council that a portion of the Flag Rock Project had been advertised for bids to be opened on November 13th at 2:00 P.M., City Manager's Office.

Adoption of City of Norton Code was delayed until complete study of the Code could be made.

On motion by Jim Humphreys, seconded by Robert Leonard and carried by unanimous vote Council moved that Kenneth L. Wampler be recommended to Judge of Circuit Court for appointment as City of Norton Sheriff to fill the unexpired term of O.V. Willard, deceased, said term to expire December 31, 1973.

The City Manager advised council that the Christmas Parade was scheduled for December 1st at 11:00 A.M.

Mr. Franks read letter from H.U.D. regarding Neighborhood Facility Project, advising that tentative approval has been given for the construction of the revised Neighborhood Facility Project.

Councilman McElroy inquired as to status of Senator Warren's findings on Power Rate increase.

6419

Mayor Fulks inquired as to status of old buildings which were supposed to have been torn down. The City Manager advised that the deadline for the Lay Building is December 4, 1973 at which time the Council may by resolution remove the building with City Personnel.


