

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on July 18, 1972 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Woods presiding.

Present: Archie Woods, Ike Fultz, Robert Leonard, W.F. McElroy

Absent: Jim Humphrey

Also Present: Milas D. Franks, City Manager

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mayor Woods presented resolution and plaque to former Mayor Vernon O. Flanary for his devoted services to the City of Norton.

On motion by Robert Leonard, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote the following resolution was passed: (Page 5)

Mrs. Carl Lawson appeared before council and requested that something be done to bridge in Ramsey section near old Piggly Wiggly Warehouse to eliminate hazardous condition. Council discussed this matter at which time the City Manager advised that shoulders needed to be fixed and that possibly a Slurry Seal is needed. Matter referred to city manager for investigation.

Mr. Bill Farmer appeared before council and inquired as to why Federal Street could not be made a one-way street again. Council discussed this matter with Mr. Farmer at length advising him that in their opinion there were less complaints with two-way street.

Mr. Franks presented revised paving schedule to council. Council was in agreement for No. 2 schedule to be done at an estimated cost of \$29,653.00.

On motion by Robert Leonard, seconded by ~~W.F. McElroy~~ *Ike Franks* and carried by unanimous vote W.F. McElroy was appointed on Lenowisco Board for a term of 4 years, said term retroactive to July 1, 1972.

Mr. Franks presented request to vacate a portion of Plat #2 of the Jones Add. to the City of Norton.

On motion by Robert Leonard, seconded by Ike Fultz and carried by unanimous vote council moved that request to vacate a portion of Plat #2 of the Jones Addition be referred to the City of Norton Planning Commission for their recommendation.

Mr. Leslie Mullins appeared before council and presented request for rezoning of his property on East Park Avenue.

On motion by Robert Leonard, seconded by Ike Fultz and carried by unanimous vote council moved that request for rezoning of Mr. Mullin's property be referred to the City of Norton Planning Commission for their appropriate action.

Mrs. Joe Kilgore appeared before council and presented request to replace a street with an alley on Plat #11A of the Fleming Land Company Tract. Charlie Daniels, Chairman of the Norton Planning Commission was present and stated Mrs. Kilgore had appeared before Planning Commission.

On motion by Robert Leonard, seconded by Ike Fultz and carried by unanimous vote council moved that a public hearing be advertised upon advice of City Attorney.

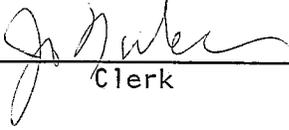
