

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on May 5, 1970 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Flanary presiding.

Present: V.O. Flanary, G.E. Hunnicutt, W.G. Stallard, Robert Leonard

Also Present: Evan Norton, City Manager

Absent: S.H. Neeley

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Monroe Moore of Hamner Avenue appeared before council regarding dirt and water running over his property from Tommy Owens excavation. The City Manager and City Engineer explained to council what had been done on the matter. They assured Mr. Moore that this matter would be taken care of.

Mr. Jake Cress spoke to council briefly on clean-up program which was in progress, pointing out he thought something should be done with parked cars on streets over city which are unlicensed, wheels off, etc.

Joe Tom Howard inquired of council as to when hearings on reassessments were to be held. Council advised the date was set for May 21, 22nd and 23rd.

Mr. Don, Davis, Director of Aware, Inc. presented report on Aware to Council. Council complimented Mr. Davis on his report.

5133

Mr. Norton reported on status of EDA and FHA Water Projects. He read letters from Congressman Wampler and EDA office regarding Neighborhood Facilities Project.

5134

Council briefly reviewed parking and traffic plan as presented by city engineer, Milas Franks.

5135

On motion by G.E. Hunnicutt, seconded by Robert Leonard and carried by unanimous vote the following Anti-Litter Ordinance was passed: (See Page 237)

Mr. Norton presented refuse collection schedule for twice a week collection on residences.

5137

Council extended Clean-up week for another week through May 16th.

5138

Mr. Franks, City Engineer, presented sketch on new elementary school showing changes in ground plan. Council was in agreement with this change.

Mr. Norton made comments on budget pointing out the benefits of the engineering department and the development office regarding the program of the city.

5140

Mr. Norton advised council that he had a letter from Department of Highways advising of public hearing on Route 74, June 17th.

Mr. Norton discussed with council the balancing of the budget - he discussed the different programs the city was in and the need for continuing.

Vice Mayor Hunnicutt pointed out he thought priority should be established on these programs, pointing out the school would have to have first priority and that first the city would have to know the cost of school.




On motion by G.E. Hunnicutt, seconded by W.G. Stallard and carried by unanimous vote council moved that the appointment of Charlie Daniels to Norton Planning Commission be confirmed, said appointment to expire July 1, 1973. 5143

Mr. Norton and Mr. Franks presented request of Roscoe Ely for closing of Ridge Avenue between his property on Craig Street and Alpha Baker property. The City Manager was requested to check into this matter further. 5144

Councilman Hunniuctt advised council he had been advised that the E.B. Tate house on Craig Street was without sewer connection. Matter referred to City Manager. 5145

There being no further business to come before the council same adjourned.
