

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on June 2, 1970 at 7:30 p.m. with Mayor Flanary presiding.

Present: V. O. Flanary, G. E. Hunnicutt, S. H. Neeley, W. G. Stallard, Robert Leonard.

Also Present: Evan Norton, City Manager.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. and Mrs. Hubbard and Mrs. Moore of Hamner Avenue appeared before Council inquiring as to what was going to be done regarding dirt and water caused by excavation on Tommy Owens property.

On motion by G. E. Hunnicutt, seconded by W. G. Stallard, Council moved that the matter be referred to the City Attorney in the morning for immediate advice.

Tommy Owens spoke briefly on the above matter.

Mrs. Hubbard of Hamner Avenue requested that a street light be installed on that section of Hamner Avenue. Referred to City Manager for checking out.

Miss Frances Fuller of Main Avenue appeared before Council regarding damage to her property by open sewer and also a fallen tree in creek bed at back of her property. She stated the channel had been changed in creek, causing water to flood her property during heavy rains. She also stated sewer was unstopped but she had not received the promised top soil to cover sewer waste on her property. Matter referred to City Manager.

Mr. Norton brought to Council's attention that bids for the new elementary school would be opened June 18.

On motion made and duly seconded, Council moved that the budget for the ensuing year 1970-71 be advertised in the Coalfield Progress June 11 for public hearing on June 18 at 7:30 p.m.

Council discussed briefly the EDA water project grant.

Mr. Norton advised there was no new development on Intern Program.

Mr. Franks reported on progress of Census of population being taken by City at this time.

Mr. Norton advised Council that as of July 1 the City Recreation Program would come directly under City. Council discussed this matter briefly.

Mr. Norton presented to Council resolution for recommending appointment of Albert H. Still as Justice of the Peace. Matter deferred to later date.

There being no further business to come before council, same adjourned.
