

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on October 20, 1970 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Flanary presiding.

Present: V.O. Flanary, Robert Leonard, W.G. Stallard, Ike Fultz, Archie Woods

Also Present: Evan Norton, City Manager

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. L.G. Colinger, owner & operator of The Hut in Ramsey section of the City appeared before council regarding disturbance he and others in Ramsey were having with the boys down there. He stated he had brought a boy into court but he was dismissed by the Judge without any punishment. He also stated the police department was doing all they could do but without backing of court it was no good. Council discussed this matter at length. Mr. Norton advised council they were working on something to try to eliminate the situation down there. He stated they were having a meeting Wednesday night at the Church of God, Ramsey, Oct. 21st, with all residents of Ramsey to try to work out something on this matter. 5293

Council discussed at length the recommendations made by the Norton Highway Safety Commission and the comments on the recommendations by Chief Kelly and City Engineer Franks.

On motion by Ike Fult, seconded by Archie Woods and carried by the following votes council moved that the 7 items as recommended by the Norton Highway Safety Commission be accepted subject to State approval on Item 2. W.G. Stallard - No; Ike Fultz, - Yes; V.O. Flanary - No; Robert Leonard - No; Archie Woods - Yes. Motion not carried for lack of majority votes. 5294

On motion by W.G. Stallard, seconded by Robert Leonard and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved that the recommendations of Norton Highway Safety Commission No. 3 thru No. 7 be accepted and Item No. 1 and No. 2 be deferred for further study. (Recommendations Page 267) 5295

Chief Kelley advised council of their plans for Halloween. 5296

Mr. Norton advised council that the Planning Commission would like to meet with the City Council to study the Comprehensive Plan for the City of Norton. 5297

Mr. Norton advised that he and Mr. Franks would be attending the Highway Meeting at V.M.I. Lexington, October 29th and 30th. 5298

The City Manager advised that Public Housing Project was the same and that they were trying to get ground broken by November 1st. 5299

Mr. Norton advised that EDA Water Project plans would be completed very shortly. 5300




Councilman Woods inquired as to gasoline bids for city. Mr. Norton advised they had already been sent out, received and awarded to low bidders. 5302
