The following ordinances were duly proposed and seconded:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norton, Virginia, that: PART III. The Building Code. Chapter 3. Plumbing Code of the City of Norton, Virginia, as heretofore adopted on February 18, 1969, is hereby repealed in toto and is void and of no effect. 4962

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norton, Virginia, that the National Plumbing Code as adopted heretofore by reference in the National Building Code is hereby repealed in toto and is void and of no effect. 4963

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL of the City of Norton, Virginia, that the Building Officials Conference of America (BOCA) Plumbing Code 1968 Edition is hereby adopted by reference as a part and portion of the Code of the City of Norton in addition to the initial Plumbing Code of the City of Norton, Virginia, as set forth in Part III. The Building Code. Chapter 3 of the Code of the City of Norton. It is hereby expressly understood that when there are conflicting statements between the initial Plumbing Code of the City of Norton, Virginia, and the newly adopted BOCA Basic Plumbing Code, 1968 Edition, then the BOCA Basic Plumbing Code shall prevail and supersede the initial Plumbing Code of the City of Norton, Virginia.

An emergency existing, these ordinances shall be in force from the date of their passage.
