

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on November 5, 1969 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Flanary presiding.

Present: V.O. Flanary, G.E. Hunnicutt, S.H. Neeley, W.G. Stallard

Also Present: Evan Norton, City Manager

Minutes of Previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Charlie Bond, Manager of C. & P. Telephone Company appeared before Council regarding bid for franchise for telephone company.

On motion by S.H. Neeley, seconded by W.G. Stallard and carried by unanimous vote council moved that bid be awarded to C. & P. Telephone Company for telephone franchise, as advertised. 4991

On motion by G.E. Hunnicutt, seconded by W.G. Stallard and carried by unanimous roll call vote council appointed Mr. Robert A. Leonard to fill the unexpired term of R.L. Collins, resigned, as member of City of Norton Council. 4992

Council discussed with City Manager Legal Service Agreement with City Attorney on Water Bonds. No action taken. 4993

Council briefly discussed resolution on Virginia Appalachian Health Service. Matter tabled. 4994

Mr. Norton discussed with council water projects with regard to EDA Application; Leakage as regarding pressure zones and Pitometer Survey.

On motion by S.H. Neeley, seconded by G.E. Hunnicutt and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved that ~~XXXXXX~~, the city manager be authorized to purchase pressure reducing valves to be used on the present system. 4995

On motion by S.H. Neeley, seconded by G.E. Hunnicutt and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved that W.R. Hamner, Cecil Gardner and Hoke I. Horne be recommended to Judge of Circuit Court for appointment to the Board of Assessors, with salary to be twice amount paid before but not in excess of \$250.00 each. 4996

Mr. Norton advised council of meeting he had had with joint Committee of Town of Wise and City of Norton. Mr. Norton reported that the committee recommended to the governing bodies that steps be undertaken immediately to link the Norton and Wise sewer and water systems. The town manager of Wise and City Manager of Norton were requested to begin an engineering study to include estimates of construction and an agreement between Norton and Wise as to how these linkages would be affected and how operated once completed. Mr. Norton recommended to the City Council that the council immediately approve the recommendation of the joint committee and proceed without delay toward affecting this hook-up with details of the construction and operation to be agreed upon. 4997

On motion by S.H. Neeley, seconded by G.E. Hunnicutt and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved that the recommendation of Mr. Norton and of joint committee be approved.

On motion by S.H. Neeley, seconded by W.G. Stallard and carried by unanimous vote council moved that the correction of budget as presented by city manager be approved. 4998

Councilman Hunnicutt gave a brief report from Mr. Robinette of Lenowisco. 4998

Mayor Flanary brought to council's attention complaint regarding trash on Virginia Avenue Back of Norton Salvage Company. 4999

There being no further business to come before the council same adjourned.
