

July 21, 1964

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on July 21, 1964 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor B.E. Ball presiding.

Present: B.E. Ball, A.O. Umstead, J.C. Holcomb, J.B. Taggart

Absent: Archie Woods

Also Present: C.F. Jester, Jr., City Manager & R.T. Winston, Attorney

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Council deferred action on auxiliary police force until full council is in attendance. #2790

Mr. Jester presented requests for street light by Bill Dean for a street light at the intersection of the ██████ Interstate R.R. Track and the road to the City dump and of Octavia Stidham for a street light across the street from the Housing Project on 12th Street. #2791

On motion by J.C. Holcomb, seconded by J.B. Taggart and carried by unanimous roll call vote, council instructed the City Manager to have the two above lights installed.

Mr. W. P. Kanto appeared before council in behalf of St. Mary's Hospital in regard to improvement of alley back of their property. Matter referred to City Manager for action. Mr. Kanto briefly advised council of the financial status of the School Board at the end of the year. #2792

Mr. Jester gave a report of delinquent taxes thru July 20th. Taxes = 1,113.47 Penalty & Interest = 203.30; total of \$1,316.77 #2793

Mr. Jester advised council that the committee appointed to look into the possibilities of purchasing a billing machine met July 21st and that in their opinion there was a need for the machine in the offices. They recommended that a second-hand machine for water bills, taxes and accounts receivable be purchased. Council instructed the City Manager to get bid proposals on such a machine from local merchants as well as out of state companies. #2794

Mr. Jester presented the Treasurer's Report for the month of June, 1964. A brief discussion followed. #2795


Council commended the City Treasurer and City Manager on the financial condition of the City and of the bookkeeping and reporting procedures. #2796
