

Sept. 1, 1964

An organization meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on September 1, 1964 at 8:30 A.M.

Present: J.C. Holcomb, J.B. Taggart, V.O. Flanary, C.W. Bryant

Absent: Archie Woods

The Clerk administered the Oath of Office to Mr. C.W. Bryant and Mr. V.O. Flanary. 282

The clerk, acting as temporary chairman, asked for nominations for position of Mayor of the City of Norton. 282

On motion by J.B. Taggart, seconded by C.W. Bryant and carried by unanimous roll call vote J.C. Holcomb was elected Mayor of the City of Norton.

On motion by V.O. Flanary, seconded by C.W. Bryant and carried by unanimous roll call vote J.B. Taggart was elected Vice Mayor of the City of Norton. 282

On motion by J.B. Taggart, seconded by C.W. Bryant and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved that all city appointments, employees, including specifically the city manager, clerk of council, police court justice, city attorney, assistant clerk of council, all boards and commissions in existence as of yesterday be continued during the tenure of the new council until further action. 282

On motion by J.B. Taggart, seconded by C.W. Bryant and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved that the present council endorse the resolution passed last Friday by the old council, indicating willingness to help finance future activities of the Lee-Norton-Scott-Wise-Redevelopment Authority. 282

There being no further business to come before the council same adjourned.
