

February 20, 1962

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on February 20th, 1962 with Vice Mayor A.O. Umstead presiding.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. William Jackson appeared before Council asking permission for the issuance of an off premise wine license to James Vaughn, T/A The Steak House. On motion by J.C. Holcomb, seconded by W.R. Hamner and carried by unanimous vote, permission was granted for the issuance of an off premise wine license to James Vaughn, T/A The Steak House. #2102

Mr. H.G. Dalton, Commissioner of Revenue appeared before Council and presented an exoneration for 1959 personal property tax which he had erroneously assessed against George Eldridge. On motion by J.C. Holcomb, seconded by Frank Horsman and carried by unanimous vote, council moved that the 1959 personal property tax in the amount of \$16.45 be refunded. #2103

On motion by J.C. Holcomb, seconded by W.R. Hamner and carried by unanimous vote, council moved that taxi driver's permit be issued to Eugene Carter. #2104

Mr. Jester read a letter to council from Mr. Leroy Cason, Manager of the C. & P. Telephone Company in answer to a resolution passed by Council on January 16, 1962. Council instructed the City Manager to acknowledge the letter from Mr. Cason, expressing their anticipation of the improvements. #2105

Mr. Winston reported to council his findings on privilege license for contractors, merchants and others out of town doing business in the City. #2106

A group of citizens from S. 4th Street, with D. Goode as spokesman, appeared before council asking that a hard surfaced road be made from S. 4th Street to main highway. This matter was referred to the City Manager with the request that he give it special attention. #2107

Messrs. Dave & Bob Isaac appeared before council in the interest of a 50' strip of land west of Coalfield Progress building on Park Avenue for a building site. Council discussed this matter with the Isaacs and advised them of the situation and that they would have the City Manager look into this matter and see what could be done about it. #2108

Mr. Jester advised council of the necessity of appointment of #2109 assessors for the reassessment which would begin in March. He also asked that they be giving consideration to the appointment of an equalization Board. Council deferred action on this matter until next council meeting.

There being no further business before the council same adjourned.
