

July 10, 1962

A Special called meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Building on July 10, 1962 at 1:15 P.M. with Mayor B.E. Ball presiding.

Present: B.E. Ball, A.O. Umstead, J.C. Holcomb

Mayor Ball announced that the purpose of the meeting was for the consideration of the passage of an ordinance authorizing the issuance of \$400,000 of Bonds of the City of Norton to Finance the Cost of Constructing a Sewage Disposal System and additional sewer lines. #2207

On motion by J.C. Holcomb, seconded by A.O. Umstead and carried by unanimous roll call vote "An Ordinance authorizing the issuance of \$400,000 of Bonds of the City of Norton to finance the cost of constructing a sewage disposal system and additional sewer lines, and providing for the submission of the question of issuing said bonds to the qualified voters of said City," passed at the July 3rd council meeting was rescinded. #2208


On motion by J.C. Holcomb, seconded by A.O. Umstead and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the following ordinance "authorizing the issuance of \$400,000 of Bonds of the City of Norton to Finance the cost of constructing a sewage disposal system and additional sewer lines, and providing for the submission of the question of issuing said bonds to the qualified voters of said city", considered by the council at July 10th meeting was passed and that said ordinance be made a part of the minutes. #2209
