

November 21, 1961

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on November 21, 1961 at 7:00 P.M. with Mayor B.E. Ball presiding.

Present: B.E. Ball, A.O. Umstead, W.R. Hamner, J.C. Holcomb, Frank Horsman

Also Present: C.F. Jester, City Manager and W.T. Bowen, City Attorney

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The City Manager advised council of the bids received on purchase of a police car for the City Police Department. #2059

On motion by Frank Horsman, seconded by A.O. Umstead and carried by unanimous roll call vote, council moved to defer purchase of police car.

Mr. Jester advised council of the inspection of the City streets by representatives from the Resident Engineer and his Assistants. #2060

The following resolution was introduced by J.C. Holcomb, who moved its adoption, seconded by W.R. Hamner and carried by unanimous roll call vote: #2061
BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia, that this Council guarantees the payment of all costs and expenses which may be incurred in the delivery procurement of Federal Surplus Properties which may be obtained for the Civil Defense Program in Norton, Virginia.
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT C. Franklin Jester, Jr., Coordinator of Norton, Virginia, be and he hereby is designated to apply for and receive said properties.

On motion by J.C. Holcomb, seconded by W.R. Hamner and carried by unanimous roll call vote, council moved the adoption of the revised Local Emergency Operational Plan. #2062

On motion by J.C. Holcomb, seconded by Frank Horsman and carried by unanimous vote, council moved that the Abstract of votes cast in City of Norton election on November 7, 1961 be made a part of the minutes of proceedings of Council. #2063


The following resolution was introduced by W.R. Hamner who moved its adoption, seconded by Frank Horsman and carried by unanimous vote: #2064
BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Norton, Virginia, that B.E. Ball, Mayor, be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to sign, on behalf of the City of Norton, Virginia, a certain water pipe line agreement, dated November 21, 1961, between the Interstate Railroad Company and the City of Norton, Virginia.

by unanimous roll call vote , council moved that the agreement
between Anna Mae Carter and the City of Norton be accepted.
