The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on the above date at 7:30 P. M. with Mayor B. E. Ball presiding.

Present: B. E. Ball, F. W. Glass, W. R. Hamner, J. C. Holcomb, Sol Cury.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

The City Manager recommended that street lights be installed in alley #1753 between Craig Street and Sixth Street and Roberts Avenue west of 2nd Street.

On motion by J. C. Holcomb, seconded by W. R. Hamner and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the City Manager was instructed to have Old Dominion Power Company install the two above lights.

Mr. Hamner, upon request of colored delegation expressed appreciation #1754 to council and school board for their work done at the colored school. He also stated that they would like some additional work done on Roberts Avenue. Referred to City Manager.


The City Manager reported that the count for the 1960 census was now #1755 5,066.
