

July 15, 1954

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Building on the above date at 7:30 P. M. With Mayor B. E. Ball presiding.

Minutes of the ^{last} meeting were read and approved.

The application of Lottie Hatfield to sell beer on-off premises at the Kozy Nook was tabled for investigation to be reported at the next meeting. #400

A report of the timber survey by the Virginia Forestry Service was presented to council for study and upon a motion by W. R. Hamner, seconded by A. O. Umstead and carried by roll call vote, the City Manager was authorized to offer the timber for sale on bid acceptances by council and to further include in the bids the removal of all timber and underground upon the proposed impounding area. #401

Upon a motion by A. O. Umstead, seconded by W. R. Hamner and Carried by roll call vote, the City Manager was authorized to sign the contract that has been submitted by the Chester Engineer Company for the preliminary work on the construction of a dam as outlined. #402

The City Manager reported to council that his recommendation of \$3,000.00 for the purchase of the existing lines in the West Norton road from W. F. Baker was refused and that Mr. Baker asked \$8,000.00 instead. The matter was referred to the City Manager and City Attorney for further consultation with Mr. Baker. #403

Upon a motion by W. R. Hamner, seconded by A. O. Umstead and carried unanimously, the City Manager was authorized to purchase the public works building as specified at a total cost of \$4750.00 with the provision that the lease first be obtained from the Interstate Railway Company on the proposed site. #404

There being no further business before the council same adjourned.
