A special meeting of the City Council was held in the City Manager's Office at 7:30 P. M., August 27, 1956.

The following members were present: Fred H. King, W. R. Hamner and A. O. Umstead.

This meeting was called for the purpose of considering the signing of contract #2 covering the new impounding dam with Bennie Snyder of White Sulphur Springs, West Virginia. #848

The following resolution was introduced by W. R. Hamner, seconded by A. O. Umstead and passed by unanimous vote of all those present.

RESOLVED, that Acting City Manager, W. P. Kanto, be, and he is hereby, directed and authorized to execute a contract of even date herewith on behalf of the City of Norton, Virginia, with Bennie L. Snyder, contractor, for the impounding dam, reservoir and appurtenances, all pursuant to the terms, plans and specifications as prepared by Chester Engineers of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the performance bond and labor and materialman's bond this day submitted to the council and approved by Fred B. Greear, City Attorney, be, and the same is hereby, ratified, approved and confirmed and Acting City Manager, W. P. Kanto, is hereby authorized and directed to execute said performance bond and labor materialman's bond for and on behalf of the City of Norton, Virginia.

There being no further business before council same adjourned.
