A special meeting of the City Council was held on November 9th at 5:00 P. M. in the Municipal Court Room with Mayor B. E. Ball presiding.


All members of council except W. R. Hamner were present.

On a motion by Sol Cury, seconded by Fred H. King and Carried by unanimous roll call of those present, the following resolution was duly introduced and passed: #907

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Norton, Virginia, that the City of Norton, Virginia, does hereby agree to participate with Wise County and such other governmental units as may be interested in the formation of an airport authority to be known as THE CUMBERLANDS AIRPORT AUTHORITY. The cost and representation shall be apportioned among the governmental units participating in the authority according to their respective populations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting and a copy mailed to the Board of Supervisors of Wise County, Virginia.
