
That whereas the qualified voters of the City of Norton in the special election held on January 14, 1958, approved the activation of the Housing Authority for the City of Norton, Virginia, by a substantial majority of the votes cast in said election:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises BE IT RESOLVED that the Honorable B. E. Ball, Mayor of the City of Norton, be, and he is hereby notified of the adoption of the Housing Authority of the City of Norton by the qualified voters of said city. Further that it is therefore in order for the Mayor of the said City of Norton to appoint five persons as Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the City of Norton.
