At a meeting of the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia, held on the 3rd day of February, 1958, the following resolution was introduced, seconded and unanimously passed:

WHEREAS, Clinch Valley College has filled a great need for the people of Southwest Virginia and surrounding territory; and,

WHEREAS, the steady growth of Clinch Valley College has assured the people of this area of the great desire of our younger people for a higher education;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City Of Norton, Virginia, respectfully requests the Members of the General Assembly of Virginia to appropriate the sum of Three Hundred Fifty Thousand (350,000) Dollars to Clinch Valley College for the construction of an auditorium-gymnasium and the additional sum of Fifty-six Thousand (\$56,000) Dollars for operational expenses at Clinch Valley College to promote better learning and more complete facilities to satisfy the need of the eager students of Clinch Valley College.
