

March 18, 1958

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on the above date at 7:30 P. M. with Mayor B. E. Ball presiding.

Present: B. E. Ball, Fred King, Sol Cury, W. R. Hamner & A. O. Umstead

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Mrs. William Jelf, representing Norton Band Boosters appeared before #1251 council in regard to the city's participation in a Youth Center and a Youth Program for the coming year. No action taken.

Mr. George Wharton, Chairman of the Cumberland Airport Authority #1252 appeared before council requesting that the city's share of the airport expense be placed in next year's budget, which amount is 13% of \$50,000, or \$6500.00. No objections were voiced by the council.

Mr. Greear, introduced Mr. Daniel F. Aderholt of the State Water #1253 Control Board of Richmond.

Representatives from the following engineering firms appeared before #1254 council to present their firms proposal for the sewer project:

Mr. Frank Horsman appeared before council representing the Burton #1255 High School Band, requesting \$1,000 for the band.

On motion by Sol Cury, seconded by A. O. Umstead and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the city manager was authorized to give the Burton High School Band \$1,000 from the City's contingency fund.

Mr. Norton gave a brief report on his recent talk with the State #1256 Highway officials in Richmond.

Mr. Greear advised council that he would be in Richmond the following week and if the council so desired he would try to negotiate with the highway officials in another manner. Council authorized Mr. Greear to proceed as outlined.

On motion by Fred H. King, seconded by W. R. Hamner and carried by #1257 unanimous roll call vote, the City Manager was authorized to pay to the Norton Fire Department \$5.00 for each fireman's car to purchase their city tag.

On motion by Sol Cury, seconded by Fred H. King and carried by unani- #1258 mous roll call vote, the following taxicab owners were granted privilege license for 1958: B. B. Collier, W. C. Marshall, Jim Vaughn, G. H. Green, Toney Slaughter, Ralph Wilson, Elmer Heaberlin, Pearl Williams, J. C. Johnston, N. W. Stallard, John E. Lovell, C. C. Amburgy, Odell Greer.

Mr. Fred B. Greear read a letter from the Federal Housing Authority #1259 after which the following resolution was introduced by Sol Cury, seconded by A. O. Umstead with Sol Cury, A. O. Umstead, B. E. Ball and W. R. Hamner, Voting YEA and Fred King not voting:

WHEREAS, at its meeting of February 4, 1958, this Council adopted a Resolution authorizing the Mayor and Council Clerk to execute the Cooperation Agreement between the City and the Norton Redevelopment and Housing Authority submitted at the meeting and said Contract was executed on behalf of the City on February 10, 1958; and

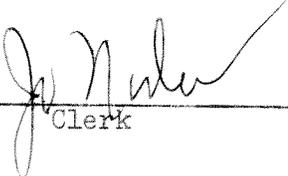
WHEREAS, the form of the Contract authorized to be executed was not made part of the Resolution for identification purposes and it is necessary that the Agreement submitted to said meeting and authorized to be executed should be identified as the Contract actually entered into between the City and the Norton Redevelopment and Housing Authority;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Norton as follows:

The form of Cooperation Agreement hereto attached marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof, is the same form of Agreement submitted at the meeting of the Council held on February 4, 1958, and authorized to be executed on behalf of the City, is identical with the form of Agreement executed on February 10, 1958, and the execution thereof by the Mayor as attested by the City Clerk, shall be and the same is hereby in all respects approved, confirmed and ratified.

Mr. Ball gave a brief report on the Civil Defense meeting in Abingdon #1260 at which he and Mr. Norton Attended.

There being no further business before council same adjourned.
