A group of citizens with Mr. W. H. Witt, Jr. as spokesman appeared before council requesting the City to participate in the County Mobile Library. #1364

On motion by Sol Cury, seconded by F. W. Glass and carried by unanimous roll call vote of all those present, the council moved that the city participate to the amount of \$250.00 in the Wise County Public Library Demonstration, and further authorized the Mayor and Clerk of the Council to sign the application for participation. #1364


