

October 21, 1958

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court room on the above date at 7:30 P. M. with Mayor B. E. Ball presiding.

Present: B.E. Ball, W.R. Hamner, Fred King, Sol Cury & F.W. Glass

Minutes of the previous council meeting were read and approved.

Mrs. Burlie Lioutza appeared before council regarding application for beer license for the New York Cafe. On Motion by Sol Cury, seconded by W. R. Hamner and carried by unanimous vote, council authorized the issuance of an on-off premise beer license to Mrs. Burlie Lioutza T/A New York Cafe. #1373

Mr. Norton presented taxicab driver's application of Ivan Vance and John H. Sturgill. On motion by Sol Cury, seconded by Fred H. King and carried by unanimous vote, taxicab driver's certificates were issued to Ivan Vance and John H. Sturgill. #1374

A brief discussion was held on the completion of the dam project in which Mr. Norton presented the final estimates of Bennie Snyder and of Penn. Drilling Company. He also stated again to council the agreement the Chester Engineers made on their recent visit to Norton on October 19th to pay for the expense of getting the extra material out of pipe. #1375

Mr. Norton asked council's opinion on the quarterly distribution of A. B. C. Profits. Council expressed themselves as being satisfied with yearly distribution as it comes at a time to meet the city's need. #1376

Mr. Norton advised council that the ^{va municipal} League Dues would be raised beginning in 1959. #1377

Mr. Trimble of the Paintsville Appliance Company appeared before council and gave a brief report on the status of the television cable system for city of Norton. #1378

On motion by W. R. Hamner, seconded by Fred H. King and carried by unanimous vote, the appointment of Mr. E. O. Breeding and Mr. E. L. Ford as Appraisers for Route #23 was approved. #1379

Mr. Norton presented council with a report from Dept. of Public Welfare. #1380


