

June 19, 1959

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on the above date at 7:30 P. M. with Mayor B. E. Ball presiding.

All members of council were present and answered to roll call.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Monroe Parker outlined his recreation program for the summer to the Council. #1492

On Motion by W. R. Hamner, seconded by Fred H. King and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Mr. W. T. Bowen was appointed as member of City of Norton School Board for a term of three years to expire June 30, 1962. #1493

On motion by Sol Cury, seconded by F. W. Glass and carried by unanimous vote, the City Manager was instructed to have a resolution drawn up showing appreciation of Mr. Frank Jones' service on the City of Norton School Board. #1494

The City Manager advised that the terms of F. B. Kline and W. P. Kanto as members of the Norton Planning Commission would expire June 30, 1959. #1495

On motion by Sol Cury, seconded by Fred H. King and carried by unanimous vote, F. B. Kline and W. P. Kanto were reappointed as members of Norton Planning Commission for a three year term ending June 30, 1962.

The City Manager advised council that the following members of Board of Zoning Appeals terms had expired: W. H. Witt, Sr.; J. B. Taggart and C. C. Clark, Sr. #1496


On motion by Sol Cury, seconded by W. R. Hamner, W. H. Witt, Sr., J. B. Taggart and Joey Caruso were appointed as members of Board of Zoning Appeals for a term of two years expiring June 30, 1961 and Jack Helms and C. L. Porter be appointed for a term of three years, expiring June 30, 1962.


Mr. Norton advised council that the State Coordinator of Civilian Defense would be in Norton on June 23rd at 8:00 P. M. to hold a meeting with the City of Norton's Civil Defense organization. #1497

Mr. Norton and the City Council discussed the proportionate sum of the City and County debt fund and Gladeville District Fund and also the interest of the Norton City School System in Delinquent taxes collected by the county for previous years. Council instructed the City Manager to go ahead with the studying of this and complete the report by next council meeting so that agreement can be reached with the county in regard to this as soon as possible. #1498

On motion by Sol Cury, seconded by Fred H. King and carried by unanimous vote, the City Manager was instructed to issue taxi driver permits to H. E. Reece and Max Jenkins. #1499
