

The regular meeting of the Norton City Council was held in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building on Tuesday, April 6, 1993 at 7:30 p.m. with Vice Mayor Mays presiding.

Present: Roy Roberts, Jack Wallace, and William Mays

Absent: Robert Raines and Ron McCall

Also Present: E. W. Ward, City Manager and Joe Pippin, City Attorney

The invocation was given by the City Manager and was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance which was led by Marty Hagy.

Upon a motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Jack Wallace, and passed by unanimous vote, Council moved to adopt the minutes of the March 16, 1993 meeting as presented.

There was no response to the Mayor's call for visitors.

15639

A public hearing was held on An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia Amending Portions of Section 25 of the Norton City Code as Pertains to Sewer Use Standards.

Mr. Ward advised this was brought up at the last meeting and he had been instructed to advertise this public hearing. This ordinance is one of the requirements to get the remainder of our I&I funds from the Virginia Revolving Loan Fund.

Vice Mayor Mays opened the public hearing.

There were no comments from the public.

The Vice Mayor closed the public hearing.

Upon a motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Jack Wallace, and passed by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved to adopt An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia Amending Portions of Section 25 of the Norton City Code as Pertains to Sewer Use Standards. (Insert)

At this time, it was the consensus of Council to cancel items 7-B and 7-C which call for water and sewer taps in the County until there is a full council present.

Mr. Marty Hagy, Chairman of the City of Norton School Board, was present and gave Council a synopsis of the School Board Budget for 1993-94. Also present and speaking were Mr. Cliff Daniels, a member of the School Board, and Dr. Al Armentrout, Superintendent of the Norton City Schools.

Mr. Hagy advised that they were requesting \$191,102 over last year's budgeted amount for a total budget request of \$1,308,817.

Following questions from Council, Mr. Hagy thanked Council for their support to the school system.

Vice Mayor Mays thanked Mr. Hagy and advised this will be discussed in Council's budget work sessions.

Mr. Ward advised Council that they needed to schedule a budget work session. With the next scheduled council meeting of April 20th having a heavy agenda, he suggested either the 13th or 27th of April. Due to some scheduling problems, Mr. Ward is to work on this and get back to Council members.

Upon a motion by Jack Wallace, seconded by Roy Roberts, and passed by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved to go into Executive Session to discuss personnel as per 2.1-344(A) (1) of the Code of Virginia as amended and probable litigation as per 2.1-344(A) (7) of the Code of Virginia as amended.

The Vice Mayor declared the meeting in Executive Session.

Upon a motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Jack Wallace, and passed by unanimous vote, Council moved to go back into regular session.

The Vice Mayor declared the meeting back in regular session.

The Clerk then polled each member of Council as to the Certification of Executive Meeting with each answering aye. The Clerk then read the entire Resolution of the Certification of Executive Meeting.

Upon a motion by Jack Wallace, seconded by Roy Roberts, and passed by unanimous vote, Council moved to adopt A Resolution of the Certification of Executive Meeting. (Insert)

Mr. Mays advised there were no announcements to be made regarding probable litigation and appointments.

In his announcements, the City Manager advised:




There were no comments from Council.
