

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Council Chambers on August 16, 1988 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Daniels presiding.

Present: Roy Roberts, Jack Wallace, Cliff Daniels, Robert Raines, William Mays

Also Present: E.W. Ward, City Manager & Kenneth Asbury, Attorney

The invocation was given by Father Albert Perrara followed with pledge of allegiance led by Bill Stokes. 14213

The Mayor announced there would be an amendment to the agenda - Item 6B will be deleted and 6C will include personnel. 14214

On motion by William Mays, seconded by Jack Wallace and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that minutes of August 2, 1988 be approved as presented. 14215

The Mayor called for visitors from the audience who were not on agenda.

Linda Sturgill appeared before council regarding skate boards. She stated she had been approached by several people in regard to children riding them on back streets and sidewalks. She also stated she had been approached by people of both sides of the question. She is not directly involved but suggested that the recreational director be directed to find a place suitable for the riding of skate boards in the City. Council instructed the City Manager to ask the City recreation director to look into this, this to be worked out with police department. 14216
Linda Sturgill also ask the question as to whether the City intended to route the trucks thru West Main Avenue. Council advised this had not been discussed.

The Mayor approached the matter of kids parking along Park Avenue and the litter they were causing. Council briefly discussed this matter. Referred to Park Director and Police Department. 14217

Discussion of water reserves - The Mayor reported the City Manager had given him an update as of 4:15 P.M. on this date. Stated rains had increased the reservoirs since last report up to 88.6 million gallons. The reservoirs have gained about 1'. 14218

Update on the C-N-W Regional Wastewater Authority and infiltration/inflow. Mr. Ward, City Manager, presented Mr. E.E. Brooks, Regional Director of C-N-W Wastewater Authority, who gave an up-date on progress of the project.

Mr. Bobby Lane of Dewberry & Davis addressed the second part of the discussion dealing with infiltration/inflow. He brought council up-to-date on this matter and advised council that the Authority had directed Mr. Brooks and himself to appear before each of the three localities requesting commitments from the three localities as to the removal of II from your sewer such that the plant will not be subject to excessive II. The Authority would request that the commitment from City would be forthcoming as soon as possible. 14219

Council discussed this matter briefly with Mr. Lane - the infiltration/inflow part. Councilman Mays ask the City Manager to bring them up-to-date on II schedule of five years back. The City Manager brought them up-to-date.

Mayor Daniels suggested Council needed to have a work session before signing the resolution of commitment. It was decided to have this meeting on Tuesday, August 30th at 7:00 P.M. in Council Room.

On motion by Robert Raines, seconded by Jack Wallace and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved to go into executive session to discuss personnel as Per. 2.1-344 (A) (1) of the Code of Virginia, As Amended and Legal Matters as Per 2.1-344 (A) (6) of the Code of Virginia, As Amended. 14220

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Robert Raines and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved to go back into regular session.

The Mayor declared council back in regular session. 14221

The Mayor advised there was no announcement on legal matters. With regard to personnel he advised Council authorized the City Manager to fill a budgeted vacant position within the City. Authorized him to advertise this position.
