

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on June 17, 1986 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Present: Roy Roberts, Robert Raines, George Hunnicutt, Milas Franks, Cliff Daniels.

Also Present: Charles R. Brown, City Manager and Kenneth Asbury, City Attorney.

Invocation was given by Father D'Aurora

On motion by Milas Franks, seconded by Robert Raines and carried by unanimous vote, council moved that the minutes of June 3, 1986 be approved as presented. 13484

A group of citizens from East Norton and Guest River section were present and presented request that something be done about the quality of water they were receiving. Some of the citizens speaking on the subject were Berniece Wilson, Mary Lou Salyer, Beatrice Lawson, Lloyd Wilson, Leroy Workman, Mrs. Gardner, Mr. Jackson, Mr. Fields and Kathleen Boggs. Council discussed this matter at length with the citizens present and ask that the City Manager go from door to door and take samples of the water for testing and bring back a report to the council. Each of the Councilmen spoke on this matter. Council assured these citizens that whatever was possible would be done to help this situation. 13485

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Milas Franks and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that "An Ordinance Adopting the Budget for the City of Norton, Virginia for the Fiscal Year July 1, 1986 thru June 30, 1987. Appropriating Funds for All Contemplated Expenses of the Municipality for the Fiscal Year and Placing Levies Upon all Real Estate, Personal Property, Bank Stock, Licenses, Automobile Licenses, Water and Sewer Rates and Revenue Sharing" be passed on second reading. Mr. Charles R. Brown introduced Miss Shelly Knox, the new Director of Parks and Recreation for the City of Norton. 13489

Request for funding in the amount of \$14,778 for Mountain Empire Community College, from 9110-5804, contingency.

Council briefly discussed this matter.

On motion by Milas Franks, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that request for funding in the amount of \$14,778 for

Mountain Empire Community College, to be taken from Contingency 9110-5804 be approved since the County of Wise has approved their prorata share and in keeping with the spirit of cooperation with the County and City. 13491

Discussion of Proposed Resolution and Member Agreement as Pertains to the Virginia Municipal Liability Pool.

Council briefly discussed this matter, Mr. Asbury also addressed this subject. Mr. Brown ask if they would be able to meet on June 26th, at which time, he would have more details and figures on this subject. Council agreed to have called meeting on June 26, 1986 at 8:30 A.M. 13492

Discussion of Proposed Amendment to the Century Cable Franchise Agreement, Mr. John Taylor and Mr. Clyde Abey presented proposed changes for TV Franchise for Century Virginia Cable Co. Mr. Asburyspoke on the subject. Council discussed this matter at length with the TV Cable representatives. No action necessary until public hearing on this matter. 13493

Discussion of time and place for Organization Meeting for City Council. Council decided to have Organizational Meeting on July 1st at 8:30 A.M. 13494

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Raines and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved to go into executive session to discuss personnel as Per 2.1-344 (A) (1) of the Code of Virginia, as amended. 13495

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Milas Franks and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that council go back into regular session. The Mayor declared council back in regular session. 13496

Nomination to Board of Zoning Appeals postponed until later date. 13497

Roy Roberts nominated Robert Isaac for reappointment to City of Norton School Board for three year term, said term to expire June 30, 1989.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Raines and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the nominations be closed.

The Mayor declared Robert Isaac reappointed to City of Norton School Board for three year term, said term to expire June 30, 1989. 13498

Appointment to Norton-Wise Regional Waste Water Treatment Authority for initial terms as indicated, 5-15-87; 5-15-88; 5-15-89.

Appointment to 5-15-87 postponed.

Milas Franks nominated Charlie Daniels for the term to expire 5-15-88.

Robert Raines moved, seconded by Cliff Daniels that nominations be closed.

The Mayor declared Charlie Daniels appointed for term to 5-15-88.

Cliff Daniels nominated William Mays to term of 5-15-89.

Robert Raines moved, seconded by Milas Franks and carried by unanimous vote that nominations be closed.

The Mayor declared William Mays appointed to term of 5-15-89. 13499

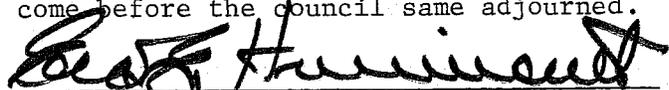
Cliff Daniels nominated Shelly Knox to the Head Start Board to fill the unexpired term of Anne Massey, said term to expire August 31, 1988.
