

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on September 4, 1984 with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Present: Roy Roberts, George Hunnicutt, Cliff Daniels

Also Present: C.R. Brown, City Manager & Kenneth Asbury, Attorney

The invocation was given by Sister Ann.

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the minutes of August 21, 1984 be approved as presented. 11345

Sister Ann, representing St. Mary's Hospital and people of 3rd Street appeared before council requesting consideration be given to completion of the road in hospital area on into 3rd Street in the hollow section. Council discussed this matter at length with those interested persons present. Council instructed the City Manager to get a cost estimate of the work needing to be done on this street extension and bring back to council at next meeting. 11346

Request by the City Manager for \$428.78, said funds to come from 9110-5804 Contingency, to reimburse Mr. J. Earle Brown, for the City picnic.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that reimburse J. Earle Brown, \$428.78 for City's picnic, said funds to come from 9100-5804, contingency. 11347

Request by Social Services to Amend their 1984-85 Budget by \$10,800, said funds in the form of a grant from the Commonwealth of Virginia. No local funds are involved.

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that amend the 1984-85 budget by \$10,800 for Social Service Budget increase, said funds to be secured from the Commonwealth. 11348

Nomination of a Voting Delegate to the VML Conference.

Cliff Daniels nominated Mr. C.R. Brown as voting delegate to VML Conference.

Roy Roberts moved nominations be closed, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous vote. The Mayor declared Charlie Brown elected by acclamation. 11349

Introduction of new Fire Chief delayed until next regular council meeting. 11350

Comments by the City Manager - I met with Norton Industrial Development Authority today regarding new revenue bond issue. We must respond to Richmond by October 1st. We will be ready by Sept. 18th meeting with recommendations. A reminder of work session to be held at 7:00 P.M. on Sept. 11th. On Monday we got 2.3" of rain here. 11351

Councilman Daniels said he would like to see the City picnic as a line item. Also complimented the conditions of Flag Rock. Stated it was better than he had seen it since he moved back. 11352

Mayor Hunnicutt also complimented the looks of area at Flag Rock.

Councilman Roberts, stepped aside as Councilman, to announce as employee of the C. & P. Company, the change over to E.S.S. Office on November 3 or December 3rd. This will not hurt services in any way, just additional features. 11353

Attorney Asbury brought council up-to-date on status of tax sale. 11354

There being no further business to come before the council same adjourned.
