

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on April 5, 1983 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous 10813 vote, Council moved that the minutes of March 15, 1983 be approved as presented.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that minutes of March 31, 1983 be approved as presented. 10814

The City Attorney presented a resolution of the City of Norton, Virginia "Authorizing the Industrial Development Authority of the City of Norton, Virginia to Hold Public Hearings." Council discussed this resolution with the City Attorney in detail.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that the following Resolution of the "City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia Authorizing the Industrial Development Authority of the City of Norton, Virginia, to Hold Public Hearings" was passed. On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the City Manager be authorized and directed to acknowledge this letter he received from Senator Jones. 10818

Mr. Frank Sexton, Jr., representing Peoples Bank of Pound, presented request for one (1) Equivalent Residential sewer connection Outside of the City Limits.

Council discussed this matter briefly.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by the following roll call votes, Council moved that with the recommendation of City Planning Commission the Council grant permission for a sewer connection equivalent to one Outside the City Limits next to Wise Plaza: Roberts, NO, McElroy, Daniels, Hunnicutt, YES. 10819

The City Manager advised he would be attending a HUD Conference in Wytheville on Wednesday of this week. 10820

Mr. Brown brought council up-to-date on meeting he attended this day regarding Job Training Partnership Act. He reported on the details of this meeting with Council discussing same with him. He advised that the City of Norton drew Education for which the City Council would have to provide a nominee for this position. 10821

Mr. Brown advised council that the Budget would be ready within 7 to 10 days 10822 for distribution. Council decided to wait until budget is received to set work session.

Mr. Gregg Harris, representing a group of Citizens of City of Norton appeared before Council and presented petition that the Norton City Council repeal that portion of City Code prohibiting the sale of alcoholic beverages from midnight Saturday

until 6:00 A.M. on Monday, which ordinance was enacted on March 7, 1963.

Council discussed this matter at length. Council decided to have public hearing on this matter. Council decided to have public hearing advertised for April 28th at 7:00 P.M.


