

A special meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on April 28, 1983 at 7:00 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Present: George Hunnicutt, W.F. McElroy, Cliff Daniels, Vic Jones, Roy Roberts

Also Present: C.R. Brown, City Manager & Kenneth Asbury, Attorney

The Mayor announced this meeting was called for public hearing to consider "An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Norton Repealing and Nullifying Section 13.6 of the Code of the City prohibiting the Sale of Beer or Wine within the City between the Hours of 12:00 P.M. of each Saturday and 6:00 A.M. of each Monday." 10845

The Mayor also advised there was a couple of things which have come up which requires action by the City regarding traffic Control System in down-town Norton. He stated the State had made this mandatory but would be brought back to council for ratification at regular meeting. Council briefly discussed matters regarding traffic control system. 10846

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that the following "Resolution of the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia, Appropriating Matching Money for the Improvements of the Traffic Signals on Park Avenue in Norton, Virginia" be passed. (Insert)

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that "A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia Authorizing and Directing the City Manager to Execute an Agreement between the City of Norton and the Commonwealth of Virginia, Department of Highways and Transportation with Reference to the Project for the Improvement of Traffic Signals" and "An Agreement between a Municipality and Virginia Department of Highways and Transportation" be passed. (Insert)

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that "An Ordinance of the City of Norton, Virginia, Authorizing the City Manager to Reduce for a Temporary Period, Not to Exceed Sixty Days at a time the Speed Limits on Park Avenue within Norton Extending from Eleventh Street to the Intersection of Proposed Alternate Route 58, and Designated as Route 23", be passed on first reading. (Insert)

An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Norton Repealing and Nullifying Section 13.6 of the Code of the City Prohibiting the Sale of Beer or Wine within the City between the Hours of 12:00 P.M. of each Saturday and 6:00 A.M. of each Monday.

The Mayor announced the public hearing was now open.

Gregg Harris, attorney for the request for change, spoke briefly on this subject. Michael Goode spoke on subject against the sale of beer or wine on Sunday. He stated he was here in opposition to the subject. Also that he was representing his church and community. 10847

Council briefly discussed this matter.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by the following roll call votes, the following ordinance "Repealing and Nullifying Section 13-6 of the Code of the City of Norton, Virginia Prohibiting the Sale of Beer or Wine within the City Between the Hours of 12:00 P.M. of each Saturday and 6:00 A.M. of each Monday" be passed on first reading. Roberts, McElroy, Hunnicutt, Jones, YES; Daniels, No. (Insert)

This ordinance to be brought up for second reading on May 17th.


Council set Wednesday, May 4th at 7:30 P.M. for second work session. 10848


The City Manager reported to Council paving being done on High Knob Road by W. & L. Construction Company.
