

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on June 21, 1983 at 7:30 P.M.

Present: Roy Roberts, Vic Jones, Cliff Daniels

Absent: George Hunnicutt, Mayor, W.F. McElroy, Vice Mayor

Also Present: C.R. Brown, City Manager and Kenneth Asbury, Attorney

In absence of Mayor and Vice Mayor it was in order for an Acting Mayor to be nominated.

Roy Roberts nominated Victor Jones as Acting Mayor for this meeting.

Cliff Daniels moved the nominations be closed.

Victor Jones was declared Acting Mayor by acclamation.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that minutes of June 7, 1983 be approved as presented. 10900

Mr. Bill Delp appeared before council regarding dog leash law which was passed on April 1st. Council and the City Manager discussed this matter with Mr. Delp and advised him that a new method was proposed for use in keeping the dogs up. Matter referred to City Manager for action. 10901

Mrs. Ruby Edwards appeared before council in behalf of her mother, Mrs. John Leho, Sr., requesting a hearing regarding the vacating of S. 8th Street. She stated she had an application filed by her mother. The City Attorney advised Mrs. Edwards had taken the necessary steps and the next thing was for an advertisement for the hearing.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the City Manager be authorized to advertise for public hearing the vacating of this lot on S. 8th Street. 10902

Review and Aoption of the Revised Emergency Operations Plan for the City of Norton, Virginia. Council briefly discussed this revised plan.

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved adoption of the "Revised Emergency Operations Plan for the City of Norton." 10903

Request for \$9,016 from the Capital Account of the City to Start Replacing Sidewalks, Pending Adoption of City Policy. Mr. Brown advised council that he and City Attorney had been tied up with other City Matters and had been unable to have a policy for presentation, and requested that this be tabled.

On motion by Daniels, seconded by Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved to table this matter. 10904

Review, Discussion, and Proposal to Amend the Parking Ordinance of the City of Norton. Council discussed this matter briefly with citizens present. 10905

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved we re-enact or extend the Parking Meter Ordinance to June 30, 1984.

Approval of the Norton Industrial Development Authority Intént to Issue \$4,500,000 in Industrial Revenue Bonds. Council discussed this matter briefly. Ralph Blevins in the audience spoke on this matter. 10906

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that the following resolution regarding The Industrial Development Authority Issuance of bonds was passed. (Insert)

Request for \$1,446.23, said funds to come from contingency, as final payment for services from Mullins, Winston, Stout and Thomason.

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that pay amount of \$1,446.23 to firm of Mullins, Winston, Stout and Thomason, said funds to come from Contingency Fund. 10907

Review of a Request for a Rate Hike from Century Virginia Corporation, as pertains to Cable T.V. Council briefly discussed this matter. 10908

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that advertise hearing on proposed increase in rates for July 19, 1983 at 7:30 P.M.

Review and Comments of the Proposed Paving List for this summer. Council discussed this proposed paving list at length with the City Manager.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that authorize the City Manager to advertise for bids Kentucky Avenue to corporate limits and High Knob Road and in addition ask for scarification prices of Kentucky Avenue to Route 74, this to be put in such manner so that we may elect options. 10909

Special Presentation, City Engineer, Progress to Date in Leak Detection, Infiltration/Inflow Work and Drainage Findings. 10910

Ron Peaks, City Engineer presented a detailed up-date on the work they had done on the storm drainage, filtration-inflow, and water leak detection programs. Discussed results from what had been found, any repairs they had made and what they planned to do coming up ahead on those three programs.

Council discussed each of these programs with Mr. Peaks.

A Resolution of the City of Norton, Virginia Agreeing to Comply with the minimum Standard Requirements for a Virginia Community Development Block Grant.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the following resolution, "Agreeing to Comply with the Minimum Standard Requirements for a Virginia Community Development Block Grant" was passed. (Insert) 10911

Request for Permission to Apply for an Economic Development Agency Grant for a Water Tank and the Necessary Lines.

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the following resolution "Agreeing to Comply with the Minn. Standard Requirements for a Economic Development Administration Grant under the Emergency Jobs Acts (Public Law 98-8)" was passed. (Insert) 10912

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go into executive session to discuss personnel as per 2.1-344 (A) (1) of the Code of Virginia as amended.


On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go back into regular session. 10913


The Mayor declared council back in regular session.
