

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on November 15, 1983 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Present: George Hunnicutt, W.F. McElroy, Cliff Daniels, Vic Jones, Roy Roberts

Also Present: C.R. Brown, City Manager and Kenneth Asbury, Attorney

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that minutes of November 1, 1983 be approved as presented. 11036

Anne Massey, as member of the Norton Clean & Beautiful Commission appeared before Council and advised them of a community project that a local restaurant was doing in the way of a tray liner. She advised they were going to use it now and also in "Keep America Beautiful" in the spring. 11037

Bill Henry appeared before council inquiring as to why he hasn't been able to get a water tap to his new residence and asking council to give consideration to this matter. Council advised him this matter was on the agenda and would be taken up at this time. 11038

Bardin Thrower presented audit for year ending June 30, 1983. Mr. Thrower highlighted the audit, summarizing each department. He advised council he would be glad to answer any questions at any time. 11039

The Mayor advised it was time for public hearing of the Carrying Forward of Financial Encumbrances for the General Fund, School Fund and Social Services, as Per the Auditor of Public Accounts. Mr. Brown read the three categories. 11040

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved authorize to carry over encumbrances from 82-83 fiscal year to 83-84 fiscal year from General Fund, \$83,766.74; from School Fund \$89,826.48 and Social Services Fund \$1,038.00.

Public Hearing on "An Ordinance Adopting the Motor Vehicle Code as Amended and the Code of Virginia as Amended on Driving a Motor Vehicle while intoxicated. 11041

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that incorporate by reference the Statute of Virginia as Amending Driving a Motor Vehicle while intoxicated" on first reading.

An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia, to Amend and Reordain the Sub-Division of the City, as to the General Requirements and Minimum Standards of Designs for the Development of Sub-divisions within the City of Norton.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that Sub-Division Ordinance be referred back to work session between council and the Planning Commission. Meeting time tentatively scheduled for Tuesday Nite, Nov. 22, 1983. 11042

Acceptance of Sub-Division Improvements at Hawt horne, that includes Water and Sewer Lines, Fire Hydrants, Drainage and Streets. Mr. Brown advised he did not have all the information he needed on this matter and ask that this be tabled until such was completed. Council agreed for this to be tabled. 11043

Discussion of Water Reserves - Council discussed this matter at length. Each of the Councilmen spoke on this subject. Also Mr. W.P. Kanto was present and spoke on this subject. 11044

Mr. Brown presented packets to council and advised he was having these given out at the Treasurer's office at the request of the customer. 11045

Discussion of New Water Taps, in and out of the City during a water emergency.

Mr. Brown presented three requests for water - two outside and one inside. 11046
Council agreed that all requests for water inside city should be considered. All
single taps outside the City which do not require new construction of water line.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous
vote, Council moved they go into executive session to discuss personnel as Per 2.1-344
(A) (1) of the Code of Virginia, As Amended. 11047

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote,
Council moved they go back into regular session.

The Mayor reported they had hoped to come up with nominations for Equalization
Board. Found out upon investigation some of the people had not been contacted, had
not indicated willingness to serve. Hope once again to have that at the next council
meeting. 11048


Vice Mayor McElroy stated he thought council should congratulate the Girls

meeting. 11050


Councilman Daniels inquired as to when the City is going to have a Codification
