

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on February 2, 1981 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that minutes of January 19th 1981 meeting be adopted as presented.

Consideration of update of City Code. Attorney Asbury explained to Council proposal presented by Michie Company for updating the City Code. Mr. Asbury discussed the updating of the code with council, pointing out that the prime concern is the Criminal Code. The City Manager advised that if it was alright with council he would get with MR. Asbury to arrive at a figure for having this work done.

An item brought out in the executive session was the discussion of the further development and committment from Dept. of Housing & Urban Development which is now in limbo being switched about from HUD to State of Virginia and it appears that we must by March 1st designate a developer to offer us plans for developing the Old Community Hospital Site. Mr. Prior presented two offers for proposals and recommended the firm of Fralin & Waldron.


