

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on May 5, 1982 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Present: George Hunnicutt, W.F. McElroy, Robert Collier, Cliff Daniels, Vic Jones

Also Present: Earle Brown, Acting City Manager

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that minutes of April 20, 1982 meeting be approved as presented.

Mr. Jim Hincer, Resident Engineer, Dept. of Highways was present and discussed with council Flag Rock with reference to recreational access road. He presented an agreement covering the same. Council discussed this matter with Mr. Hincer.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous roll call vote, council moved that Project 999-146-102, N501 concerning access road to the Flag Rock Recreational Area be approved as presented and that \$29,000.00 be budgeted in the 1982-83 budget. (Insert)

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, council moved that the Mayor be authorized and directed to execute this contract between the City of Norton and Commonwealth of Virginia, Department of Highways and Transportation.

Council discussed with Mr. Hincer, Resident Engineer, erosion on Tipple Hill. He advised council that tipple hill will always have water problem and some minimum work should be done to stabilize problem.

Mayor Hunnicutt ask Mr. Hincer to give written estimate on this work. Mr. Hincer said this report would be forthcoming.

Mr. Hincer discussed with Council Traffic Light at Burton High School. He advised it had not been in plans for new highway construction but his intent was to change plans to include traffic signal light at entrance of Burton High School.

Vassie Vaught of Southwest Virginia EMS Council presented letter of November, 1981 in which they had ask the City for an appropriation of 10¢ per capita (475.70) for FY81-82 for program to train EMT personnel for City of Norton. Mr. Vaught explained this program to council in detail.

Council was in agreement for recommendation from two representatives, Sam Pickering and Dr. Deaton Smith, on E.M.S., for next budget work session.

Tony Wampler presented request for Dance License in Old Micket Building on West Main Avenue.

Council informed Mr. Wampler he must have a public hearing and advertise for it; he must do a survey and address the parking matter. Council also ask that he advertise this hearing for next regular council meeting on May 18th.

Flood Insurance Rate Map - Mr. Brown presented letter from F. E.M.A. with regard to this map. He recommended to council that this map be presented to City of Norton Planning Commission. Council was in agreement for this to be done.

Location of Clear Creek Project Water Line - Charlie Daniels presented a proposal for replacing old water lines, (Exhibit C - Attached). Council discussed this proposal at length with Mr. Daniels.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier, with the following votes, Council moved to place Clear Creek Water Line along old Route 58, bring in line on existing 58. - Daniels, Collier, Yes; Hunnicutt, McElroy, Jones, NO.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by the following votes, Council moved that place line on new 58 or service road. - Jones, Hunnicutt, McElroy, YES; Daniels, Collier, NO.

Mayor Hunnicutt ask the question "Do we proceed with Clear Creek as originally proposed?" This not being a motion, Council made an affirmation in answer to Mayor Hunnicutt's question. Hunnicutt, McElroy, Collier, Jones voted to proceed with Clear Creek and have City Manager notify Wiley & Wilson to proceed immediately with project, Councilman Daniels voted NO.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go into executive session to consider personnel (appointment) and pending contracts.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go back into regular session.

Mayor Hunnicutt declared council back in regular session.

The Mayor reported on titen of Gateway Home for Boys that City will commit to Gateway Home for Boys to lease 1.12 acres at Flag Rock recreational area on as is where is basis and in consideration the Gateway Home for Boys will give the City of Norton \$1.00 per year and in further consideration the Gateway Home for Boys will furnish the Policing of the Grounds and guard against vandalism and such other maintenance functions as are able to work out with City Manager, under guidelines as set forth by City Attorney.

No other action taken on contracts.

Robert Collier nominated Bill Clements and George Culbertson to the Norton Industrial Development Authority for four year term beginning May 10th.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that nominations be closed.

The Mayor declared Bill Clements & George Culbertson reappointed to Norton Industrial Development Authority for a period of four years, said term to expire May 10, 1986, and that City Manager be authorized to notify them of the appointment.

Mayor Hunnicutt presented resolution regarding services of John Leho, Jr. as member of Norton Fire Department.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the following resolution be passed. (Insert)

The City Manager presented the following bids for truck for the water department: King Coal Motors - \$11,500.; Morgan-McClure Chev. - \$10,230.46; Witt Motor Company -\$10,732. Cliff Daniels moved to award bid to Witt Motor and pay from Revenue Sharing Entitlement 13, and unencumbered funds from entitlement 12. Motion failed for lack of second.

The City Manager presented contract for Christmas decoration rental. The amount per year \$2303.00. Council briefly discussed this contract.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that renew contract for Christmas decorations at price of \$2303.00 less 10% paid by 15th of May and that City Manager be directed to pay by 15th of the month.

The City Manager advised council N.I.D.A. has decided not to make use of car wash on property they had recently purchased and was offering it to City if they would like to utilize its parts.

Mr. Brown advised the Interstate R.R. will turn over check for old City Shop but there are two problems: 1. No known easement for 18" sewer line. (2) Southern Railroad wants to build two holding tanks.

10463

Councilman Collier announced his wife had had a baby boy, Ryan Douglas, 4-30-82 which joined Wesley Robert Born 6-16-78.

Vice Mayor McElroy congratulated the re-elected councilmen and councilmen elect Roberts.

Council announced Budget work session & hire a City Manager would be held Tuesday, May 11th at 7:30 - 10:30 P.M.
