

A continued meeting of the June 1, 1982, City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on June 8, 1982 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Mayor Hunnicutt announced the primary reason for this continued meeting was to meet with Wiley & Wilson, Engineers for Clear Creek, who were unable to be here on June 1st.

Mr. Al Nichols, Engineer for Wiley & Wilson stated he was here to answer any questions of council concerning letter he wrote to Mr. Brown dated May 19th concerning the route of Clear Creek Water Line. He stated that at last council meeting he attended unthe direction of council we looked at two routes - one along the right of way of U.S. Bypass and the other on coal haul road to be constructed by Steve Collins on south side of Big Bypass. Mr. Nichols advised he had talked with Mr. Hincer of Highway Dept. regarding route by U.S. 58 Bypass and had also talked with Mr. Collins regarding proposed coal haul road. He advised highway department has rules regarding construction or placing water lines on their right of way. He also advised he talked with Mrs. Collins along lines of depth, etc. along the coal haul road. He introduced Mr. Les Sullivan, Geological Engineer, who explained to council some of the findings in going over each of these routes. He also discussed with council the Kentucky Avenue route. James Collins one of proposed developers talked with council on this matter. Council discussed this phase of project at length.




