

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on July 21, 1981, at 7:30 p.m. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Present: George Hunnicutt, W. F. McElroy, Robert Collier, Cliff Daniels, Vic Jones

Also Present: G. M. Newman, City Manager, and Kenneth Asbury, City Attorney

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by W. F. McElroy, and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that minutes be approved as presented.

Ruth Mundy of 1222 Chapman Street appeared before Council requesting that something be done regarding dogs that bark all night and a large part of the day. Chief Kelley reported that he had had 23 calls on dogs in this section since May 13th. He also advised the dog warden had been to this area at different times. He stated it was a problem of dogs running loose in the neighborhood. Council discussed this matter briefly with Mrs. Mundy and advised that a little more concentration would be put on this matter.

Mr. Bruce Robinette, Executive Director of Lenowisco, was present and presented an overview of East End Development Proposal. Mr. Bill Edwards and Mr. Winston Size of Dewberry Nealon were also present and went over proposed site development of BOCO, Ltd. property. Mr. Edwards presented this proposal in detail to Council for their consideration

Mr. James Peters was present and spoke on the following subjects: condition of streets, zoning laws, financial spending, and street lights.

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Mayor Hunnicutt advised the next item on the agenda was consideration of appointments.

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On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Vic Jones, and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go into executive session to discuss personnel matter.

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On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by Vic Jones, and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go back into regular session.

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Mrs. Mundy asked that one of the members of Council present motion to pass a leash law.

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Vic Jones nominated W. A. McGannon for reappointment to City of Norton Planning Commission.

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On motion by W. F. McElroy, seconded by Robert Collier, and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that nominations be closed.

Mayor Hunnicutt declared W. A. McGannon as member of City of Norton Planning Commission for four year term, said term to expire July 31, 1985.

On motion by Cliff Daniels seconded by Robert Collier, and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that Bardin Thrower, be recommended to Judge of Circuit Court for appointment to Board of Zoning Appeals to fill the unexpired term of Bill Stokes, said term to expire June 2, 1984.

Mr. Newman advised Council that at the present time the city had 121 million gallons of water and that the dam was down 3 feet. At the same time last year, the dam was down fifteen feet.

The City Manager advised that traffic study from Virginia Department of Highways had arrived. Mr. Newman briefed Council on highlights of report.

Mr. Newman advised that the City would start widening the Guest River Road intersection tomorrow.

The City Manager advised that Revenue Sharing allocation for school request was in the amount of \$19,980.

Mr. Newman advised there would be a meeting tomorrow with Wiley and Wilson, Engineers, concerning Clear Creek. He also advised there would be a meeting Thursday with Ron Workman of Planning Associates.

Mr. Newman advised that second year Community Development money has been approved in the amount of \$575,000.
