

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on June 3, 1980 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Frank Fischer and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that minutes of previous meeting be adopted as presented

Mr. William Orender of Ramsey section appeared before council regarding conditions at Flea Market in Ramsey Section. He requested that the City do something to help in keeping this section clean of debris. Council discussed this matter briefly with Mr. Orender and ask that City Manager check into this matter and see what he can come up with.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by Frank Fischer and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the following ordinance "Making It Unlawful to Fish on the Property of the Norton City Reservoir and Lake without first obtaining a License therefor and prescribing a penalty for violation and setting forth the amount of the Fees" be passed on second reading. On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go into executive session to discuss personnel appointment.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Frank Fischer and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go back into regular session.

Mayor Hunnicutt declared council back in regular session.

W.F. McElroy moved that Bill Stokes be recommended to Judge of Circuit Court for appointment as member of City of Norton Board of Zoning Appeals for three year term.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that nominations be closed.

Mayor Hunnicutt declared Bill Stokes be recommended to Judge of Circuit Court for appointment to Board of Zoning Appeals for three year term, said term to expire June 2, 1983.

Council briefly discussed amendment to Lenowisco Charter Agreement.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that "Resolution Authorizing the Mayor of the Norton City Council to sign amended Charter of the "Lee-Norton-Wise-Scott-Town of Big Stone Gap-Town of Wise Planning District Commission be passed. (Insert)

Mr. Newman presented proposed annual paving schedule for the City of Norton. Council discussed this matter briefly with Mr. Newman.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the City Manager be authorized to obtain bids on annual repaving street schedule as outlined in his Memo of May 30, 1980 with funds available from - \$66,000 County Severance Tax; \$25,000 City Severance Tax; \$54,000.00 from Community Development Funds and balance from General Fund up to a total of \$175,000. with manholes, valve boxes and curbs being fixed prior to paving.

The City Manager advised council of letter received from Dept. of Housing & Urban Development approving 1½ million dollar grant. Council discussed this matter briefly with the City Manager.

Councilman Daniels brought to Council for consideration additional development of track property at school for additional recreation program. Council discussed this matter after which they ask the City Manager to check it out to see what could be done with help of Lenowisco.

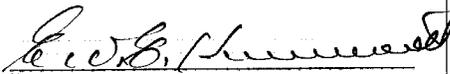

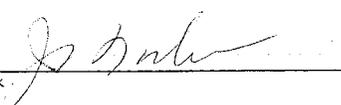
Councilman Collier brought to council's attention ecology committee which he had proposed at last Council meeting. Council discussed this matter briefly.
