

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on November 20, 1979 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Also Present: G.M. Newman, City Manager and Kenneth Asbury Attorney

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mrs. Wrightly Darnell from Dorchester section appeared before Council inquiring as to when she was going to get any water to her house. She stated she only received around 5 gallons a day. Council briefly discussed this matter with Mrs. Darnell. Council ask the City Manager to check into this matter and made recommendations to Council as to what can be done.

Mr. Glenn Barlow of East Park Avenue appeared before Council complaining of no TV Cable service, no streets or sidewalks, open sewers, dirty Norton in general. Council directed the City Manager to meet with Mr. Barlow Wednesday morning and go over the situation with him.

Mrs. Hamilton of East Park Avenue also appeared before Council regarding TV Cable to her residence in East Park Avenue. Council advised her to get up a petition of persons desiring a connection and take to Cable company and if they did not do anything about the connection, then come back to Council.

Council briefly discussed joint project with C. & P. Telephone Company. No action taken on matter.

Council briefly discussed proposed personnel policy.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Frank Fischer and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that personnel policy be adopted by consent as amended by City Attorney and amended by elimination of Election Day holiday.

Councilman Fischer ask Council to consider passing a resolution regarding Reenactment of Revenue Sharing. Council discussed this matter briefly.

On motion by Frank Fischer, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that City Attorney be directed to prepare a resolution in support of Revenue Sharing continuing.

Councilman Fischer inquired of City Manager as to how he thought City would come out in "All American City" from their trip to Michigan. Mr. Newman gave a brief report on trip and advised that everything went well.

Mr. Newman presented final report on work on school roof.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that they go into executive session to discuss personnel matter and property acquisition.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Frank Fischer, and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that they go back into regular session.


