

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on January 7, 1975 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Fulks presiding.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Blacky Voni appeared before Council requesting renewal of Pool Room License for Barney Dingus and Arthur Salyer, Jr. T/A Norton Pool Room.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by George Hunnicutt, and carried 7025 by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that Pool Room Licenses for Barney Dingus and Arthur Salyer, Jr. T/A Norton Pool Room be renewed.

Robert Bolling appeared before Council requesting renewal of Pool Room License for Frank Bolling, T/A The Sportsman.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by George Hunnicutt and carried 7026 by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that Pool Room License for Frank Bolling T/A The Sportsman be renewed for year 1975.

Mr. Lawrence Craigher appeared before Council requesting permission to license a Pool Room on Park Avenue at the White Front Cafe. No action taken. 7027

On motion by Jim Humphreys, seconded by W.F. McElroy, and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that Bob Isaac be appointed as member of City of Norton Planning Commission to fill the unexpired term of George Culbertson, resigned, said term to expire July 31, 1978. 7028

Mr. Franks gave a report on incinerator study. He recommended to Council that a joint meeting be held with Wise County Board of Supervisors after it has been determined by T.V.A. if incinerating of solid waste is feasible. 7029

The City Manager presented a copy of Order of Annexation and advised that said order was signed by Judge Cridlin on December 28, 1974. (Page 149) 7030

Mr. Franks brought Council up-to-date on restoration of water service to Dorchester. 7031

Council discussed with Mr. LaRose of Harland, Bartholomew & Associates proposed contract for Community Development Applications. 7032

On motion by Jim Humphreys, seconded by Ike Fulks; Council moved that Resolution approving contract with Harland, Bartholomew & Associates for Community Development Applications be passed, with the following votes - Hunnicutt, McElroy, Abstained - Humphreys, Fulks, - Yes. Motion died for lack of majority votes.

Mr. Franks presented proposed Ordinance adopting water and sewer rates. He also presented for Council's study a detailed report on this matter. Matter continued for further study. 7033

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Jim Humphreys, and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that Carroll Tate be reappointed.
