

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on May 6, 1975 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Fulks presiding.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved with correction in #7099 by deleting the word "fiscal" and inserting the words "by fire".

Attorney Meeks advised Council of the procedure in changing membership of School Board from three (3) to five (5). Matter tabled until later date. 7108
