

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court room on August 3, 1971 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Flanary presiding.

Also Present: Milas Franks, City Manager

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Benny Coxton, Director, Dilenowisco, appeared before council to discuss use of the old elementary school building. He expressed his appreciation for use of building and discussed with council rental, improvement, etc. of building. Council asked that N. I. D. A. representative, Mr. Coxton and City Manager get together and discuss this matter and bring recommendations back to next council meeting.

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Mr. Franks reported there was nothing new on EDA Water Project and Public Housing.

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The City Manager advised that paving bids were opened on July 27th and that Big Stone Asphalt Paving Company was low bidder. Council authorized awarding paving bid to Big Stone Asphalt Paving Company as negotiated by Mr. Franks and Mr. Cline.

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Mr. Franks advised that Green Thumb Garden Club had collected \$571.00 toward purchase of garbage cans for downtown section. He also advised that with \$300.00 from City's budget they would be able to purchase 13 more containers.

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Mr. Franks gave brief report on obtaining American Legion property. Council advised not to enter into any lease agreement for property.

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Mr. Franks advised that Mr. Roy Stewart would be unable to be UN Day Chairman due to duties in Charleston. Council advised Mr. Franks to ask Bill Necessary to accept chairmanship of this committee.

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On motion by Ike Fultz, seconded by C. W. Bryant and carried by unanimous vote council moved that Milas Franks, City Manager, be appointed to serve on advisory board to State Board of Conservation & Economic Development.

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There being no further business to come before the Council same adjourned.
