

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on March 3, 1970 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Flanary presiding.

Present: V.O. Flanary, G.E. Hunnicutt, S.H. Neeley, W.G. Stallard, Robert Leonard

Also Present: Evan Norton, City Manager

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Benny Coxton appeared before council requesting the Mayor to declare March 8th as Apple Jelly Day. They stated there was to be soliciting over city by Burton High School. 5080

Mayor Flanary declared March 8th to be Apple Jelly Day. Council & city manager each purchased a jar of jelly.

Mr. Don Davis, Executive Director of Aware appeared before council presenting some of the operations of AWARE. He also spoke on neighborhood Facilities and explained their position in this program. 5081

Mr. Norton presented letter from Area Recreation Committee requesting the employing of a full time recreation director, and that this be included in 1970-71 budget. 5082

Mr. Franks and Mr. Humphrey members of Local Highway Safety Committee appeared before council requesting the city to authorize the Highway Safety Committee to file application for Highway Safety Project Grant. 5083

On motion by Robert Leonard, seconded by W.G. Stallard and carried by unanimous vote council moved that the Highway Safety Committee be authorized to go ahead and file the application with the proper office for track and driving range, with the city's share of cost to be in kind. ✓

Mr. Norton discussed with council parking meter fines. He recommended to council that the fine be changed to \$1.00 for overtime parking. No action taken. 5084

Mr. Norton reported there was nothing new on EDA and FHA water project. 5085

Mr. Norton presented proposals from engineers and attorney regarding annexation by the City of Norton.

On motion by G.E. Hunnicutt, seconded by W.G. Stallard and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved that the city manager be authorized to proceed with annexation in accordance with proposals of the engineers and attorneys. 5086


Mr. Norton advised there were no new developments on Kentucky Avenue Project. 5087


