BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Norton, Virginia hereby grants the Virginia Department of Highways, its Agents or the Contractor permission to entry upon the property of the Norton Redevelopment and Housing Authority for the purpose of constructing the proposed Route 58 (Kentucky Avenue) in accordance with the plans for Project 6058-146-103-R/W 201.

It is further understood that this does not jeopardise any future negotiation or settlement for the proposed right of way needed for the above mentioned construction of the said proposed Route 58.

The resolution was submitted to a vote of the Council and all three members of the Council unanimously voted for the resolution. The Mayor declared the resolution passed.
