

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on December 15, 1981 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that minutes of December 1, 1981 meeting be adopted as presented.

Mr. Steve Collins appeared before Council regarding water connection to his new development on Norton-Wise Road near the old Copper Kettle Building. He discussed this matter at length with council in reference to the council authorization on outside city water connections. He advised council he was asking for their property to be annexed into the city. He also advised he had talked with the City Manager in the spring regarding this matter and he had verbally advised that he did not see any problem with having the connection made. Council was in agreement for Mr. Collins to go ahead with his project subject to approval of city attorney.

Mr. Bob Isaac, representing Planning Commission, appeared before council and presented recommendation for tax deferral.

On motion by Vic Jones, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by the following votes, Collier, McElroy, Hunnicutt, Jones YES; Daniels, NO, Council moved that the following Ordinance be passed: "An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia providing for Exemption for certain rehabilitated Commercial or Industrial or Residential real Estate." Consideration, Erosion & Sedimentation Ordinance Amendments -

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, the following ordinance "Providing for Control of Erosion and Sedimentation: Adopting minimum plans and control techniques as set forth in current Virginia Erosion and Sedimentation Control Handbook; Non-controlled Exemptions: Establishing Procedures, Administration and Enforcement: Providing penalties for violations and repealing conflicting ordinance, : was passed on first reading.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go into executive session to consider appointment and pending litigation.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go back into regular session.

Mayor Hunnicutt declared council back in regular session and reported that no action was taken on either of the matters under consideration.

Mr. Newman reported the City has 66 Million gallons water.

Council was in agreement with the City Manager for the City Employees to have one half day holiday for Christmas Eve and one half day for New Years Eve.

The Mayor and Councilmen wished those present a Merry Christmas and the Mayor expressed his appreciation for fine job done by the administrator. He also expressed his thanks to council for their attendance the past year.
