

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on March 18, 1980 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Present: George Hunnicutt, W.F. McElroy, Robert Collier, Cliff Daniels, Frank Fischer

Also Present: G.M. Newman, City Manager & Kenneth Asbury, Attorney

Minutes of the previous meetings were read and approved.

Don Jack Mullins, consulting engineer for the City was present and presented various water system improvements for the City of Norton. Council discussed these improvements at length with Mr. Mullins with regard to size of lines, if advisable to increase pipe size on two projects, easements, beginning time of project. The City Manager advised council he had a meeting scheduled for Wednesday with Bordwine Construction Company. Wright Dawson presented status of City Water Improvement Projects and status of funds as of this date.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous roll call vote, council moved that \$700.00 incidental budget be added to pending contract of Bordwine Construction Company, said funds to come from Community Development Funds.

Council directed the City Manager to get up all necessary data on easements of water line and bring back to called meeting of council.

Paul Kuczko was present and presented outline of Wise County and City of Norton Delinquency Prevention and Youth Services Project. He requested a letter in support of this program. He also ask about space in YMCA building for this program.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by Frank Fischer and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the City Manager be authorized and directed to send Mr. Kuczko letter supporting this program.

Council agreed to defer action on Parking Lot Funding for MECC until budget time.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Frank Fischer, and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go into executive session to discuss personnel matters.

On motion by Frank Fischer, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go back into regular session.

Cliff Daniels moved that Joe Siniscrope be recommended to Judge of Circuit Court for appointment to Housing Appeals Board for five year term.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that nominations be closed.

Mayor Hunnicutt declared Joe Siniscrope nominated for recommendation to Judge of Circuit Court for appointment to Housing Appeals Board for five year term, said term to expire February 18, 1985.

W.F. McElroy nominated Robert Collier as member of Sub-area Health Center.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Frank Fischer and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that nominations be closed.

Mayor Hunnicutt declared Robert Collier member of Sub-Area Health Center.


Mayor Hunnicutt reminded council of Highway hearings in Bristol on April 1st. He advised council that he planned to be in attendance.

Mr. Newman brought to Council's attention Lenowisco meeting to be held at M.E.C.C. on March 26th regarding 601 projects and others.

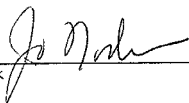
