

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on February 16, 1977 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Fulks presiding.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Elmer Montgomery appeared before council and presented verbal bid on reassessment of Real Estate in City of Norton. Council requested Mr. Montgomery to give a confirming bid in writing.

Mr. Morgan Russell of PGR Enterprises appeared before council requesting a public hearing on proposed rate increase of \$1.00 per month for TV Cable Service.
