On motion by George Hunnicutt, seconded by Vernon Flanary and carried by unanimous roll call vote (Fulks, Hunnicutt, Flanary, Yes) council moved that appoint City Manager Vicars as agent of the City Council to represent the interest of the city as to respect to Federal Disaster Administration and that he be empowered to sign all documents for the city.

On motion by George Hunnicutt, seconded by Vernon Flanary and carried by unanimous roll call vote (Fulks, Hunnicutt, Flanary, Yes) council moved that the Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision Ordinance of the City of Norton, as they pertain to the City's Flood Plain Zone be amended to establish regulations for Land Subject to Flood and in effect ratify what we already have done on March 1, 1977.
